

## REACH Information from Elektrisola Medical Technologies

Dear customer,

Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals (REACH) in Europe asks for registration of chemical substances in Europe after December 1, 2008. Polyimide tubing is not required to be listed, as it is considered as an “article”, not as a chemical substance.


Hereby Elektrisola Medical Technologies declares that our polyimide tubing products fully comply with the **REACH Regulation (EC) 1907/2006** of the European Parliament, “Registration, Evaluation, and Authorization of Chemicals (REACH)”, as interpreted by EU Court of Justice decision C-106/14 of 10 September 2015 with respect to:
